Rally with a Chalet

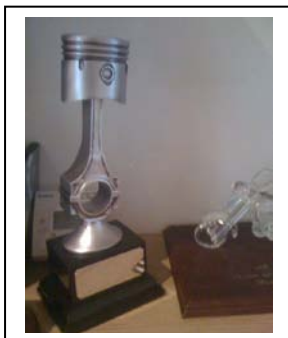

With Liam being the recipient of a rally virgin and his birthday , our Ms Whiplash had a field day.

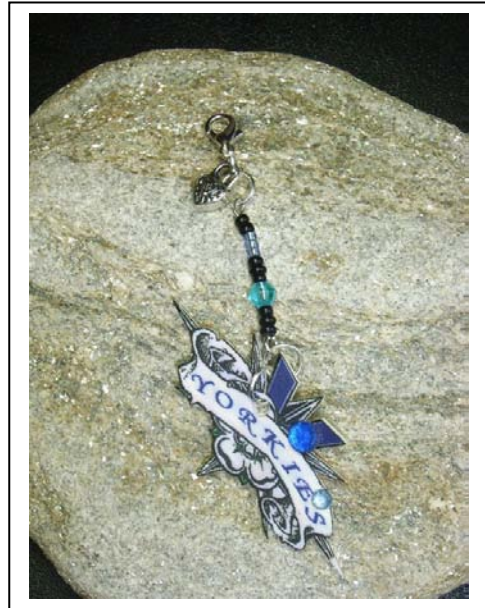
We welcomed our Yorkie Mag members lead by.
